



## Seizure Emergencies\*


- In the previous 6 months
  - 37% had prolonged seizures (>5 minutes)
    20% had seizures >30 minutes
    - 21% Convulsive
      - 18% multiple events
    - 17% Nonconvulsive
      - 13% multiple events
    - 10% Myoclonic
      - 10% multiple events
    - 12% Other
      - · 8% multiple events





